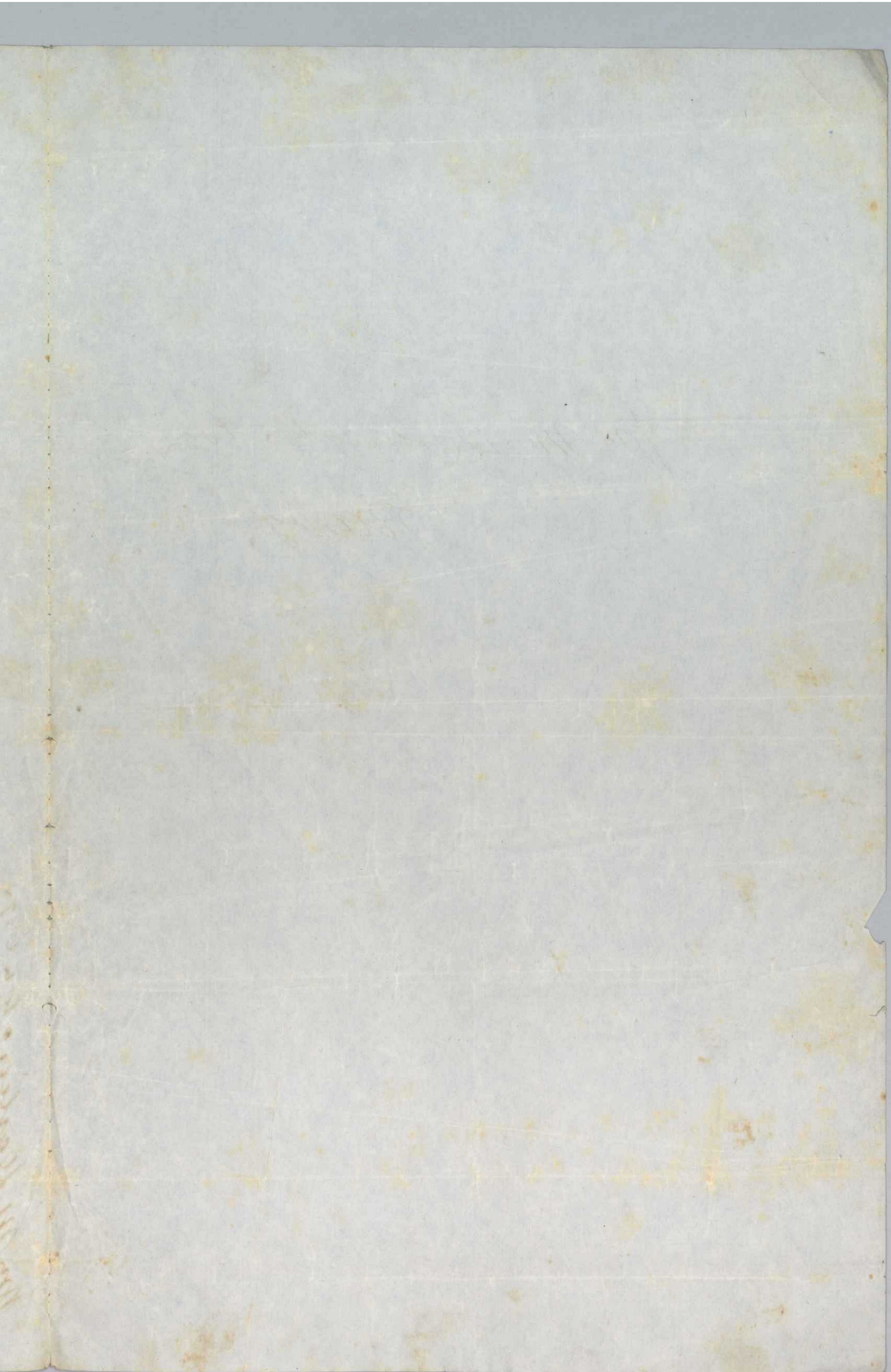


Wm M. Darlington to Wm Esq

For Sir
Herewith you will receive all the papers relating to the title to the three tracts now owned by you in Westmoreland Co viz 50 acs. in Courmyal called Elk Lick tract - The Rich Hollow tract occupied, as you know, by Mr Lowry. And the "Court" or "Muchmore" tract occupied by a son of Geo Schaele^r. I supposed you might desire to have the papers, before my return, in case you make a visit to Westmoreland. I think I left also with Mr Cowan at Greensburg a brief which I prepared of the title to the Muchmore tract. The official exemplification of the record in the case of Lee of A St Clair vs Timothy Junmont with notice to Natham Young Junr in paper is the most important document among the papers here with sent. It is the basis of St Clair's title to the Muchmore tract, & cannot be supplied as the papers & original records & accreted entries cannot now be found. I left also with Mr Cowan a certified copy of the opinion in the Sup. Ct. in the case tried last Sept of St Clair's heirs vs Atheris heirs.
