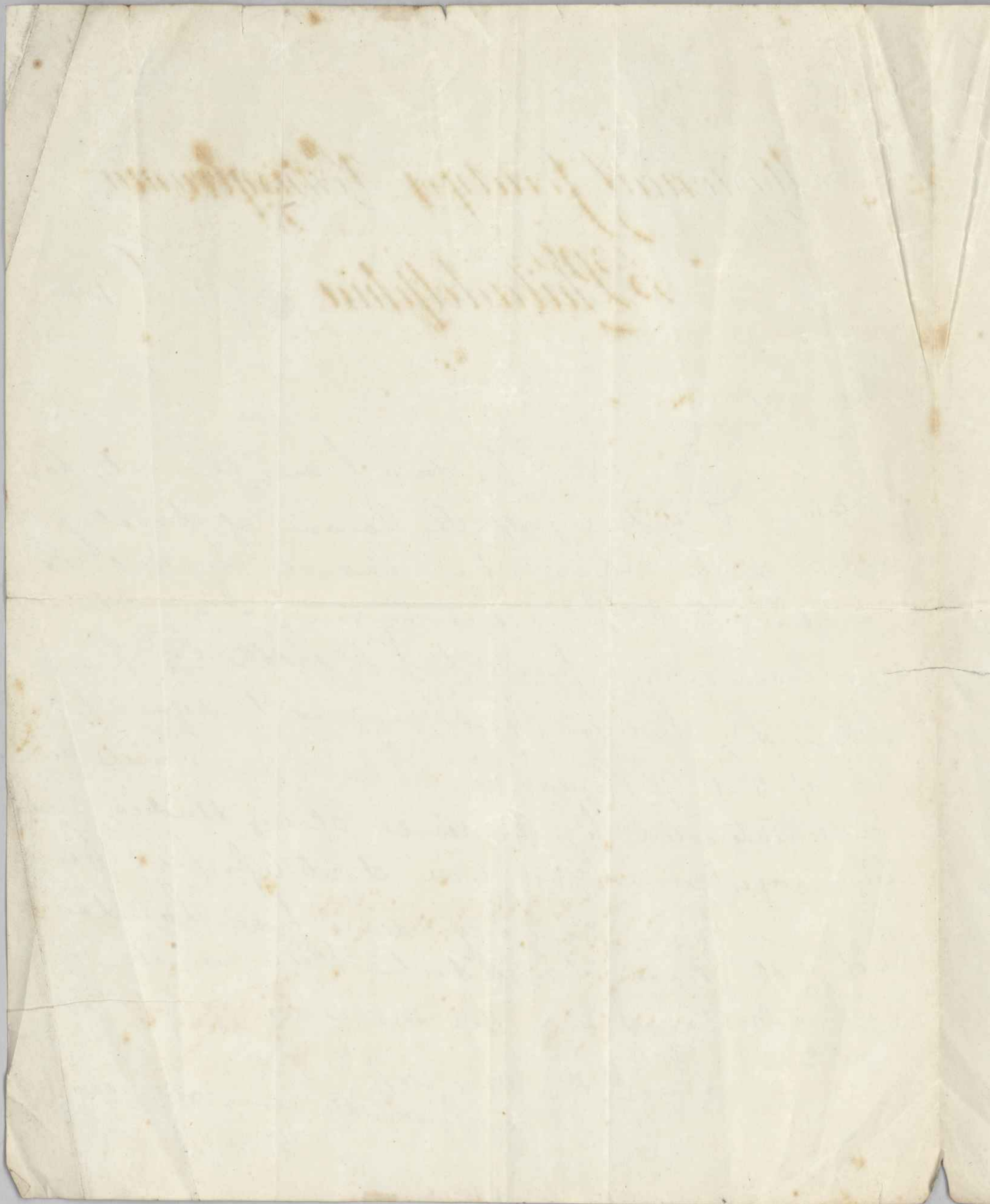
Dear Sir
