

Extract of WILL of MARY CARSON O'HARA not dated, and later cancelled:

"1st. "I bequeath to JAMES O'HARA SCULLY the dividends arising out of Five Hundred Dollars of the Stock of the Bank of Pittsburgh to be applied towards his support and education and on his arriving at the age of 21 yrs. the said amount of Stock of the Bank of Pittsburgh shall be transferred to him. In case he should die before he arrives at the age of twenty-one yrs. my said executors shall then transfer the said stock to Mrs. Denny and her successors for the purposes herein after mentioned (aid of Pious and deserving young men)

\*\* \*\*\*\*\* \*\*

3rd. I bequeth to Mrs. Nancy Scully, Mrs. Mary Lyons of Bedford, Mary, the wife of my son Butler and Mrs. Catherine O'Hara, Mrs. Margery O'Hara \*\*\*\* each Fifty Dollars.

"1st. I bequeath to JAMES O'HARA SCULLY the dividends arising out of Five Hundred Dollars of the Stock of the Bank of Pittsburgh, to be applied towards his support and education, and on his arriving at the age of 21 years the said amount of the Stock of the Bank of Pittsburgh shall be transferred to him. In case he should die before he arrives at the age of 21 yrs. my said Executors shall then transfer the said stock to my daughters Elizabeth and Mary equally.

"2nd. To Mrs. Nancy Scully, my niece Polly O'Hara, Mary the wife of my son Butler, to Mrs. Catherine O'Hara and her sister Margery O'Hara, and Nancy McAnany I bequeath each Fifty Dollars.
