North and South on the west  
side of Winchester that extends  
about half a mile there <sup>are</sup> other

much extent. There is south  
of the town a ridge which  
is called the dividing ridge  
which runs East & West the  
North west portion of the  
County is gently rolling  
and very rich in soil

The South East part is hilly  
or what is commonly called  
noby and some of it bordering  
on the river is very rough
