This right is granted for Telephone line as now located along the North side of the Freeport Road from Sharpsburg to Aspinette

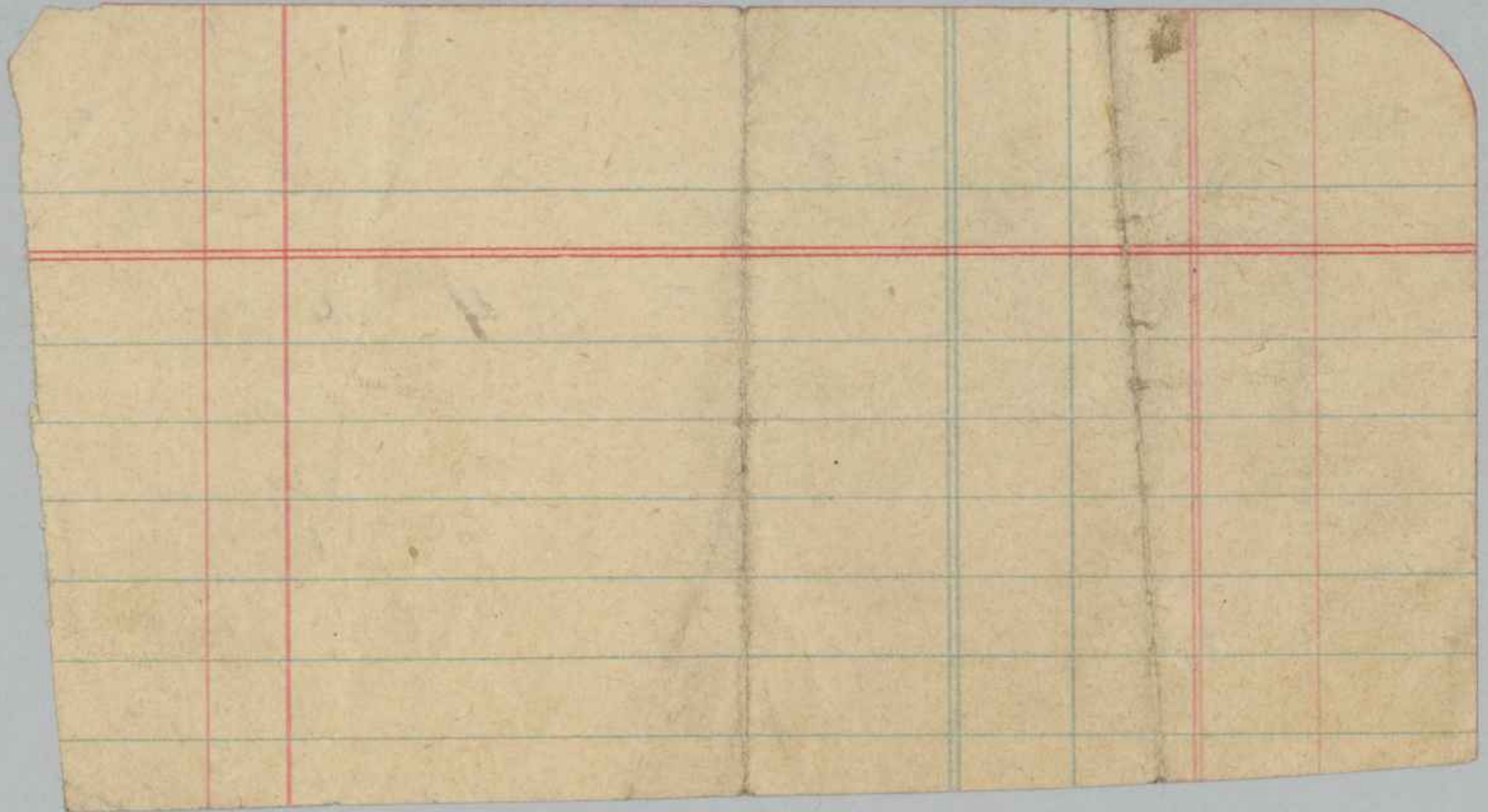

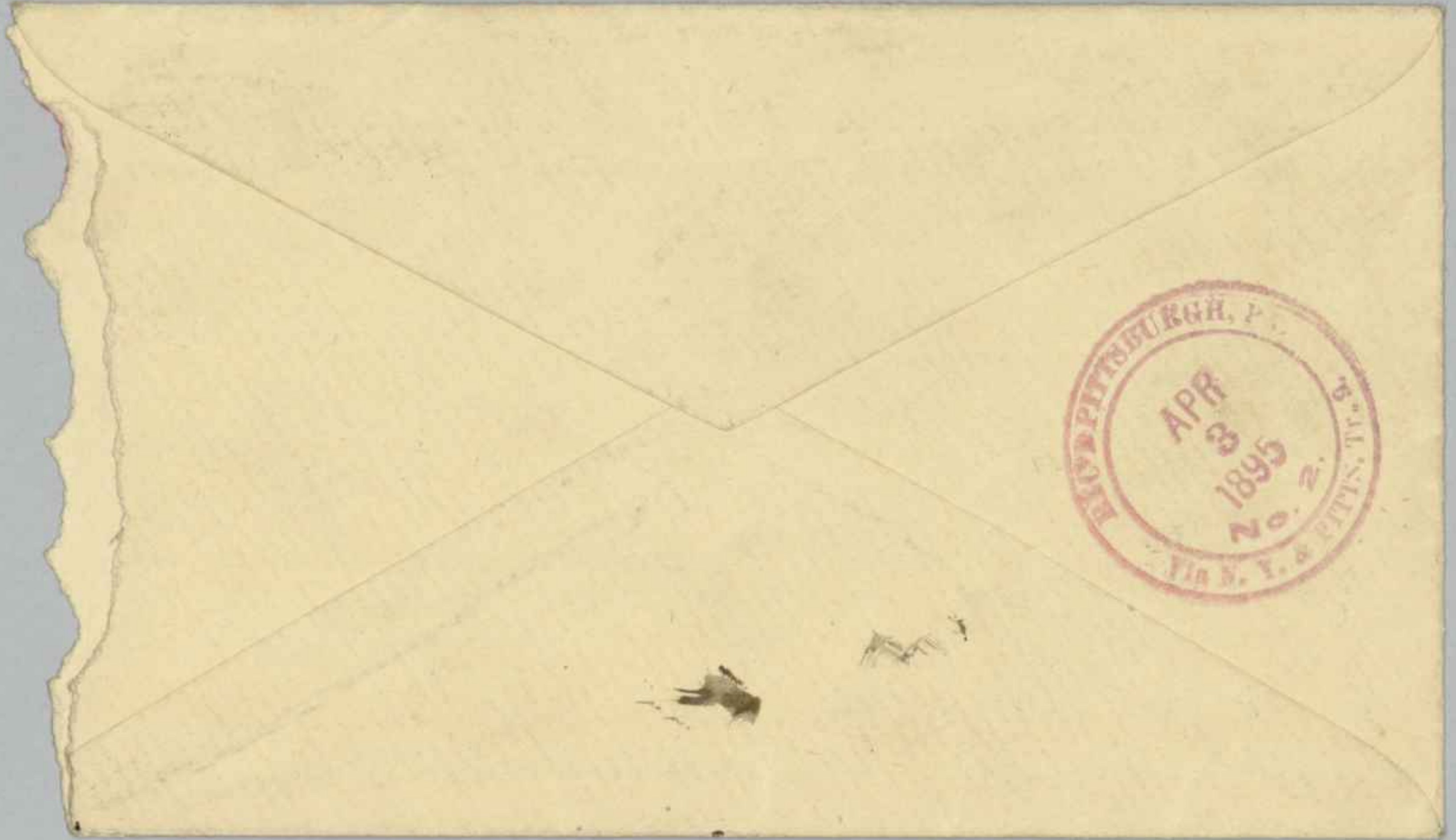
