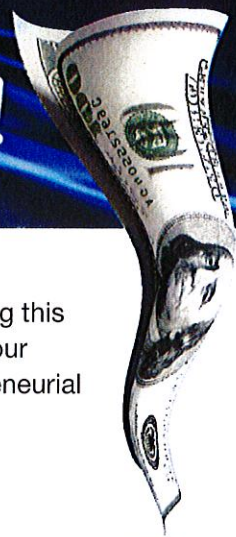


Abracadabra.... Learn to Understand Business Finances...No Magic Required!
