- 1 EP: [Right]
- 2 BJ: Mm hmm
- 3 DP: I mean uh, we've talked to somebody across the street who said that uh, you know, her dad bought that house, and he worked there for thirty years. Uhmm. The people who were, smo- who were-
- 4 EP: Right. (Now) I can't remember their names.
- DP: Sittin' smokin' a cigar across the step one night. [And] we stopped and said "Y- yinz are a wonderful couple" ((louder, different voice)) they said. [[(laughing)]]
- 5 EP: [Yeah] [[(laughing)]]
- 5 BJ: [[(laughing)]]
- 6 DP: ["Yinz are a lovely couple" (laughing)]
- 6 BJ: ["yinz are a lovely couple" uh huh. (laughing)]
- EP: [And it's amazing 'cause we never see them, but they knew,] they said we thought you got married. Because we kept seeing all these packages coming, DP: ((laugh))
 - EP: and so we figured, well they must be getting married.
- 7 DP: People watch each other's [footst-] [[doorsteps a lot. (laughing)]]
- 7 BJ: [Yeah.]
- 7 EP: [[Which is, which is good.]] Um, I think, for the most part, yea- I think it is good. I mean sometimes I think people get a little nosey about things, but.
- 9 BJ: Mm hmm.
- EP: Um. Or "nebby" as they would say [here.]
- DP: ["Nebby"], right, yeah "nebby." [[(laughing)]]
- 11 EP: [[(laughing)]]
- 12 EP: It's one thing [I try very hard] not to do, is use all those Pittsburgh words.
- 12 BJ: [So you've heard-]
- BJ: Yeah. So you've heard of Pittsburghese, huh?
- 14 DP and 02: Oh yes.
