Effective January 1st, the minimum wage increased to \$6.25 an hour in PA. On July 1, 2007, the rate will increase to \$7.15.

The 2007 Business Privilege Tax for firms in the city has been lowered from .002 mills to .001 mills, to take effect April 15th. You should receive your forms in the mail this month, or call the city's Taxpayer Services @ 412-255-8821.
