FEDERAL RESERVE BANK OF CLEVELAND EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT TO DISCUSS ECONOMIC FORECAST AT AFRICAN AMERICAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE LUNCHEON

Mark Sniderman, Executive Vice President and Chief Policy Officer at the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland will be the guest speaker during a special luncheon meeting at the Duquesne Club on November 13th. Dr. Sniderman will share his insight on current economic issues and provide an economic forecast for 2010.

Dr. Mark Sniderman is responsible for economic research, community relations, public affairs, community development, and policy analysis at the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland.

Dr. Sniderman joined the Bank's Research Department as an economist in 1976. He also served as senior economist for economic policy analysis for the U.S. Senate Budget Committee in Washington, DC, while on leave from the Bank. Before joining the Federal Reserve, Dr. Sniderman held teaching and research positions as a graduate student at the University of Wisconsin at Madison. He is a past president of the Cleveland Association for Business Economics.
