Pittsburgh is listed 85th of the best places for Business & Careers, #123 in the Cost of Doing Business, #187 in Job Growth, & #59 in Education.

New Tax Landscape

The U.S. tax landscape has undergone significant changes. The new law is designed to stimulate economic growth and development by reforming individual and corporate income taxes. Under the new law, bonus depreciation doubles from

50%-100% for property purchased between September 27, 2017, & January 1, 2023. Also, the bonus depreciation amount is now permitted for the purchase of used property, in addition to new property; a common tax plan strategy to be used by virtually all businesses.

New PA Revenue Rule

The PA Department of Revenue has issued a new ruling related to "Disallowance & Recovery of 100% Depreciation." As a result, PA law requires the amount of a 100% deduction under IRS 168(k) to be added back to taxable income, & provides no additional mechanism for cost recovery with respect to the qualified property.
