Did You Know

Governor Tom Wolf has officially declared October 2018 as "Local Chamber of Commerce Month" in Pennsylvania.

Associate Member Bridgeway Capital awarded \$1.75M from the U.S. Treasury Department's Community **Development Financial** Institutions (CDFI) Fund to invest in communities left behind. \$1 million is for loans to African American-owned businesses; and \$750K is for enterprises that aim to increase access to healthy foods in communities lacking fresh grocery options. Bridgeway was one of only 14 organizations across the country to receive an award under this initiative.

Presidential **R**oundtable **M**ember Allegheny Health Network is building a 160-bed hospital in Pine Township as part of its nearly \$1B expansion plan, including neighborhood hospitals & renovation of existing facilities throughout Western PA.

Healthcare competition is crossing the line - West Virginia University Medicine plans to expand into the Keystone State with a primary and specialty

care facility opening in Waynesburg, PA next year.
